Northwest Autism Center (NAC) is a non-profit organization, located in Spokane WA. NAC exists to support, facilitate and build accessible and comprehensive community-based approaches to help children and adults with autism spectrum disorders in the Inland Northwest. We provide comprehensive ABA services in clinic, home and school settings. We are currently looking to contract with a WA State Licensed Speech-Language Pathologist to provide services in our Early Intensive Applied Behavior Analysis Clinic for children 2-5 years old. This SLP will work closely with our team to ensure a multidisciplinary approach to treatment for children with ASD and related disorders. Clients receive services onsite M-TH from 9:00-12:00. The SLP would be required to provide one hour per week of direct services for four clients, with some flexibility in the scheduling based on SLP availability. The contract for this position would consist of up to 10 hours per week to include: direct services, assessments, report writing, program modifications, and collaboration meetings with the team.

Essential Job Duties

- Maintain and deliver high-quality services for assigned caseload of young clients in Early Intensive ABA Day Treatment Clinic
- Conduct comprehensive assessment and write appropriate individualized treatment plans and progress reports for clients
- Collect data, monitor progress, and make data-based modifications to treatment as needed
- Maintain a consistent, reliable, direct service schedule with clients
- Collaborate with Board Certified Behavior Analysts, families, and other team members to ensure program effectiveness and consistency
- Maintain regular and effective communication with client families
- Participate in team meetings

- Master's Degree in speech-language pathology
- Certificate of Clinical Competence from American Speech/Language and Hearing Association
- Experience in providing services to young children diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder and related disabilities
- Minimum of three years of related professional experience
- Qualify to become a licensed SLP in Washington State
- Knowledge and experience with Applied Behavior Analysis preferred
- Ability to work effectively on an inter-professional team
- Excellent assessment, intervention, and organizational skills
- Ability to pass background checks and clearances
