**Northwest Autism Center (NAC) is pleased to announce it will resume direct ABA treatment provision as of June 8th, 2020.** Utmost care will be taken to ensure client and staff safety, with CDC and DOH recommended health and safety precautions employed throughout clinical practices. These precautions include restricting visitors on premises and requiring masks for employees and families when on site. Virtual services provided during this time of transition will continue to be available. These include: **telehealth** services and **free screenings** (any age) provided by a Licensed Behavior Analyst, well as phone consultation and support for families and providers.
